# **ELECTION DATES**

SEPTEMBER 15	Earliest day that absentee ballots can be mailed to voters.
OCTOBER 5	Last day to register to vote or update voter registration information for the November 3 election.
OCTOBER 12	First day of advance in-person voting (aka Early Voting).
OCTOBER 30	Final day of advance in-person voting (aka Early Voting).
NOVEMBER 3	ELECTION DAY!
DECEMBER 1	General Election Runoffs for State and Local Offices
JANUARY 5	General Election Runoffs for Federal Offices (e.g., U.S. Senate)


